Think: During the next 3-5 minutes, think about your answer to the question above. Write your response in the space below.

Pair: *Now, pair with a partner to exchange ideas. What ideas did you have in common? Write those ideas below and indicate with a (+). What ideas did you not have in common? Write those ideas below and indicate with a (-). Write down any new ideas you both have now and indicate with a (*).*

Share: *Select one major idea from your “pair” section to share with the whole class. Write that major idea below. Also, as you listen to other groups sharing their ideas, record any new ideas below.*
